It is advisable to take CW 100 first, before taking any other CW workshops. Please note that even if you have already completed an advanced-level writing workshop prior to declaring the minor, you will still need to take CW 100.

Workshops must be taken in order, and prereqs ARE enforced. Introductory and intermediate courses cannot be repeated, but the advanced courses in each sequence (CW 404 and 406) may be repeated once.
